ITINERARY:

June 23, 2012 – Leave Tucson, Arizona and respective airports (LAX) to arrive in CAIRO June 24th. (overnight)

June 24 – CAIRO: Reception at the Cairo International Airport. Assistance for the Visa requirements and transfer to the hotel. Overnight –Barcelo Hotel, Cairo.

June 25 – Buffet Breakfast. Full day visits to the Pyramids of Memphis, Sakkara and Giza. Temple Valley and the Sphinx. Back to the hotel. Dinner and Overnight – Cairo.

June 26 – Buffet Breakfast CAIRO- MUSEUM - CITADEL- OLD CITY: Full Day city tour. Anthropology Museum of Egypt, The Citadel, The Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali, The Old City, The Ben Ezra Synagogue, El Moallakah Church (pending), following via the City of the Death to the Khan El Khalili Bazaar.

Dinner - Show on cruise on the Nile River.
Overnight – Cairo.

June 27– Buffet Breakfast. ST. CATHERINE. Departure from Cairo to St. Catherine. Dinner at the hotel in St. Catherine. **At midnight**, departure to the Mount Sinai. Climbing to the place where the 10 Commandments were given to Moses. Meditation. Time to enjoy the splendid Sunrise in the Desert.

June 28 – Going down the Mountain for breakfast we will visit St. Catherine Franciscan Monastery. Departure to Taba border. We will be met by our

guide, Ricardo and continue through the Arava Road to the Dead Sea. Dinner and Overnight – Isrotel Ganim Hotel Dead Sea..

June 29 – Buffet Breakfast. Free time to enjoy the sulfur waters of the lowest point on Earth, 420 meters under Sea Level. Departure to Massada. Ascension by cable car to the Fortress, built by King Herod. Visit. From there to Qumran. Visit the excavations of the Old City from the Essen Period, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Arrive in Jerusalem. Triunphal entrance to the Holy City. Welcome Toast from the Scopus Mount. Dinner and Overnight – Leonardo Inn Hotel, Jerusalem.

June 30 – Buffet Breakfast. Visit the Mt. of Olives site of the Assention and visit Pater Noster, Dominus Flevit the Church of all Nations. From there to Bethlehem. Visit the Church of the Nativity, the Caves of St. Joseph's, where we will celebrate Mass, St. Jerome, and the Cave of the Holy Innocents. Then a visit to Shepherd's Field and a special visit to Carmel in Bethlehem, the home of Blessed Mary of Jesus Crucified. Return to Jerusalem. Dinner and Overnight – Jerusalem.

July 1 – Buffet Breakfast. Enter the Old City. Visit the temple Mount. Visit the tunnel in the basis of the Western Wall. The Western Wall, View of the Mosques of Al Aqsa and Omar, the Fortress Augusta, Bethesda Pool Via Dolorosa from the Flagellation church, the Lithostrotos to the Holy Sepulcher. Mass at 11:00. Visit the Wailing Wall. Visit Mt. Sion: Last supper Room, Domitian Abbey, and King David's Tomb. Visit Saint Peter in Gallicantu. Jesus's path to Court. Dinner and Overnight – Jerusalem Hotel.

July 2 – Buffet Breakfast. Depart to Ein Karem. Visit the Visitation Church. Mass at 09:00 hrs. From there to the Holocaust Museum in Yad Vashem. Visit the Israel Museum: The Shrine of the Book found in Qumran, and the Second Temple Model. View the New Jerusalem, The Knesset or Israeli Parliament, the Menorah, and the Jerusalem University. Back to the Hotel. Dinner and Overnight – Jerusalem Hotel.

July 3 – Buffet Breakfast. Travel throughout the Judean Hills, Via Jericho. See Zachias tree and enjoy cable car to the Sight of the Mt. of Temptations. Drive to the site on the Jordan River where it is believed Jesus was baptized by John. We will arrive in Nazareth. Visit the Basilica of the Annunciation. Mass at 15:00 p.m. Visit the Church of Saint Joseph's. Return to Tiberias via Cana of Galilee, where the Wedding at Cana took place and the first miracle of Jesus. **Opportunity for married couples to renew their vows.** Arrival to Tiberias. Dinner and Overnight – Bali Hotel Tiberias.

July 4 – Buffet Breakfast. Depart to Tabgha, place of the Miracle of the Loaves and Fishes. Visit the Church of the Primate of Peter. The Mount of Beatitudes, place of the Sermon of the Mount. Mass at 10:00 hrs. From there to Cafarnaum and visit the ancient Synagogue where Jesus was praying. Visit the Octagonal Church that belongs to the Franciscans. It is built on the top of St. Peter's house. Boat ride over the Sea of Galilee. Lunch of St. Peter's Fish. Visit the Ancient Boat that could well have been the one Jesus sailed in. In the afternoon we drive to Mount Tabor, visit the Church of the Transfiguration. Depart to the Upper Galilee. Dinner and Overnight – Kibbutz Hotel Gonen.

July 5 – Buffet Breakfast. Visit and explanation of a Kibbutz community Life. Visit the Golan Heights, passing throughout the Druses Villages. Visit Baniyas or Caesarea de Philippi.
